**Anthony Clarke** is highly recognized in the agility field as a first class handler and trainer competing at the top level in British agility. He has won all major junior finals at least once, competed repeatedly at the FCI World Championships, Crufts and Olympia, won the Gold Medal at the Junior World Championships and the Bronze Medal at the European Open in the team event. Anthony has competed and taught seminars in Europe, Japan, Canada and The U.S.A, and has well over 10 years of experience working with dogs and competing for his country on many occasions. Recently Anthony has taken the role as the Coach for England's World Agility Open team.

**Tracy Sklenar** is the Owner and Training Director of Leader of the Pack (Smyrna, NY), an instructor at Susan Garrett's Say Yes Dog Training (Ontario, Canada) and the developer of Agility University. She is also a regular contributor of training articles and event coverage to Clean Run and DogSport magazines. Tracy represented the U.S. at the European Open in 2009 and 2010 and will be returning in 2012. Her dogs are multiple National Finalists and have won numerous classes at regional events, and have also appeared in national advertising campaigns. Tracy teaches agility throughout North America and has also coached World Teams for both Canada (IFCS in 2008, 2010 and 2012) as well as the USA (WAO, 2011 and 2012).
